JAZZ SONGBOOK AT WAVE HILL SUNDAY, DECEMBER 7 *Vocalist Lumiri Tubo Performs with Pianist Aaron Diehl*

Bronx, NY, November 18, 2008: Wave Hill's 2008–2009 concert season includes a holiday concert on Sunday, December 7, when vocalist Lumiri Tubo and pianist Aaron Diehl come together -- for the first time, thanks to Wave Hill's invitation -- in a musical marriage made in heaven, a lively Jazz songbook spiced with holiday flavors. With tickets priced at an affordable \$24 (including admission to the grounds), and 28 acres' worth of serene gardens and views of the Hudson River and Palisades, the experience is uniquely suited to recharge the spirit. Start the day with Sunday Brunch and follow the concert with a stroll through the gardens for a perfect escape from the relentless pace of the holiday season.

Armor Hall, an intimate setting with rich acoustics and magnificent vistas of the Hudson River and beyond, provides the perfect setting for enjoying superb performances just as the gardens and grounds reach their peak autumnal splendor. Visitors are encouraged to come early for a farm-fresh brunch, enjoy a leisurely stroll through the gardens and then settle in for an hour of outstanding music-making.

Concerts take place on Sundays from 2pm to 3pm without intermission, and are followed by a conversation with performers. Tickets for Wave Hill members are \$15; non-members pay \$24; Students and Seniors 65+ with ID pay \$21. All tickets include admission to the grounds.
