## Art, Community, Education & Science Internship

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Wave Hill's Art, Community, Education & Science (ACES) internship is a paid internship program for high schoolers ages 16–18 to explore the connections between community engagement and science-informed, informal arts education.

ACES interns assist with Family Art Project, an intergenerational and multidisciplinary program for families to come together and make art inspired by nature at Wave Hill.

#### **Program Details**

Interns will be scheduled to work on Saturdays and Sundays from June 2023 through June 2024 between the hours of 9AM and 4PM. Interns can expect to work approximately 4 to 8 hours per weekend, with a maximum of 14 hours.

Compensation is \$15.00/hour.

#### Who Can Apply

Interns must be enrolled in high school, be 16 years old by July 5, 2023, and be eligible to work in the United States. Candidates should have a strong interest in arts and science education and be comfortable interacting with members of the public, including children.

#### What to Expect

- Learn and practice skills in program facilitation, artmaking and public speaking
- Work with children and families to discover connections between science and artmaking
- Assist with family story time, including reading books aloud and facilitating related activities
- Meet guest artists, take field trips and participate in onsite workshops focused on STEAM education and college readiness
- Develop a weekend workshop for families as your final, collaborative project, as you explore program design, art education and connections to science and community
