Wave Hill is home to many different pollinators, including native bees, butterflies and our resident honeybees. Spend the day chatting with naturalists and beekeepers, visiting our honeybee hives, creating art, joining walks to see pollinators in action and more. It's peak monarch migration, so expect to see monarchs and other late-season butterflies snacking on plants in the garden.
