Wreath- and Ornament-Making, Music and Botanical Art on Display

Our popular Wreath-Making Workshops move to a cozy new location in Glyndor Gallery this year, surrounded by the outstanding botanical art on display in [the 25th Annual International with the American Society of Botanical Artists](#) (ASBA) exhibition, opening November 19. Free tours of the exhibition take place both afternoons following wreath-making sessions. Create one-of-a-kind wreaths featuring greens and other natural materials harvested from the gardens by Wave Hill's gardeners. Two sessions take place each weekend day, and one on Friday, December 2.
